JOINT CIRCULAR

In compliance with Article 1, paragraph 2 of Decree-Law no. 145/2020, the Ministries of Foreign Affairs and of Health, considering the evolution of the epidemiological situation at international level and the particularly widespread COVID-19 pandemic, upon proposal of the Executive Committee of the Social Security Institute

the list of countries which, even though they are included in one of the cases referred to in paragraph 1, letters from a) to d) of Decree-Law no. 145/2020, must nevertheless follow the procedure referred to in paragraph 1 of the aforesaid Decree-Law.

Updated list of countries:

- 1. Andorra
- 2. Belgium
- 3. Bulgaria
- 4. France
- 5. Greece
- 6. Malta
- 7. The Netherlands
- 8. The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland
- 9. Czech Republic
- 10. Romania
- 11. Spain

Moreover, they specify

that the people returning to San Marino from the countries on the list must undergo a molecular or antigen test within 48 hours of their return.

The costs of all diagnostic tests (serological tests, antigen tests, molecular swabs) required in case of return from the countries indicated above, will be charged to the persons undergoing such tests based on the fees applied by the Social Security Institute.

In case of entry into the territory of persons coming from the above-mentioned countries who are part of official delegations on an institutional visit to the Republic of San Marino, the procedure referred to in paragraph 1 of Decree-Law no. 145/2020 shall be adjusted according to specific health protocols defined from time to time on the basis of the organisation of the visit and the related activities.

This Joint Circular shall enter into force at midnight on 27 October 2020.
