

**Extract from the summary of the conclusions of the first meeting of the
EEC-San Marino Cooperation Committee**

The Parties agreed to postpone implementation of Decision No 4 until 1 April 1993, to give the Republic of San Marino sufficient time to introduce the procedures and issue the documents required under that Decision.

Pending implementation of the Decision, i. e. until 31 March 1993, and to ensure that Community provisions concerning the circulation of goods between the Community and the Republic of San Marino are correctly and simply applied, the Cooperation Committee agreed that the formalities for recording trade between the Community and the Republic of San Marino should be carried out through one of the Community customs offices listed in the Annex to the Interim Agreement, without prejudice to existing commitments entered into by the Republic of San Marino and Italy by virtue of the exchange of letters of 21 December 1972. It was agreed that, in respect of transit between the abovementioned customs offices and San Marino during this transitional period, the movement of goods originating from, or bound for, a Member State other than Italy will be subject to guarantee equivalent to that provided for in the application of internal Community transit.
